



AMANJIWO – JOURNEY THROUGH JAVA BY TRAIN

Faithful to what the name translates: peaceful soul, the Javanese sanctuary Amanjiwo presents the 'Journey through Java by Train,' where the resort's timeless elegance blends with a tranquil railway escapade. In partnership with PT Kereta Api Pariwisata, Amanjiwo has tailored a journey from Jakarta Gambir Station to Yogyakarta Tugu Station with luxurious carriages, all adorned in Aman's signature style with comfort that matches its plush.

Vast swathes of foliage unfurl before the carriages as passengers delve deeper into the region's historical richness with Amanjiwo's resident anthropologist, Patrick Vanhoebrouck. Lavish breakfast is prepared onboard before further relishing the journey over a glass of champagne or afternoon tea. Unveiling Central Java's majesty, Amanjiwo boasts 36 suites with breathtaking views of the Kedu Plain and Mount Merapi.

Awaiting the discerning travellers is a tapestry of adventures beyond the resort's luxurious confines: the UNESCO-listed Borobudur Temple, the captivating locale, and a picnic by the Progo River.

The railway voyage by Amanjiwo will set the course for the rest of 2024. April trips start with departures on the 12-15 and 26-29, followed by roughly bimonthly excursions throughout the year.
